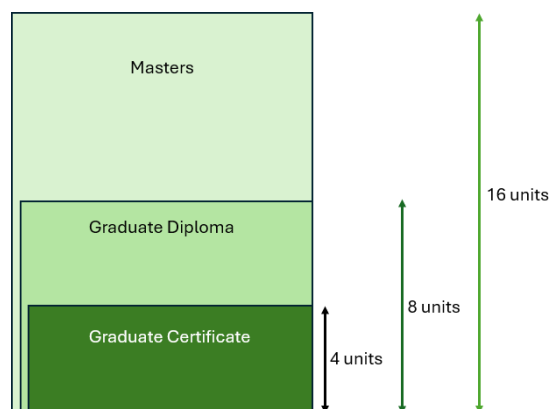

- **For Graduate Diploma:** the course of study leading to the Graduate Diploma will have specified expected learning outcomes that are consistent with AQF8 for a Graduate Diploma, and
- **For Graduate Certificate:** the course of study leading to the Graduate Certificate will have specified expected learning outcomes that are consistent with AQF8 for a Graduate Certificate.

#### Academic Entry Requirements:

- ✓ For entry to the **Master of Social Work (MSW):**

- The MSW(Q) has a minimum academic entry requirement of a bachelor's degree (AQF level 7) with **at least 8 units in the social and behaviour sciences**, or equivalent for international students, as required by the AASW.
- The MSW(Q) also has inherent requirements which are academic and non-academic requirements that are essential to the successful completion of a course.

- ✓ For entry to the **Master of Information Technology (MIT):**

- A Bachelor of IT Qualification (AQF Level 7) or equivalent from an accredited Australian Higher Education Provider or equivalent overseas qualification, or

- A Bachelor of IT (Honours) or, Graduate Certificate in IT or Graduate Diploma in IT (AQF level 8) or equivalent qualification or above from an accredited Australian Higher Education Provider or equivalent overseas qualification.

✓ For entry to the **Master of Business Administration (MBA)**:

- A bachelor's degree (AQF Level 7) in a related field or equivalent from an accredited Australian Higher Education Provider or equivalent overseas qualification, or
- A bachelor honours degree, Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma (AQF Level 8) in a related field or above from an accredited Australian Higher Education Provider, or equivalent overseas qualification.

### English requirements:

✓ For the **MSW, GDHCS, GCHCS**:

- Minimum IELTS (Academic Module): **7 overall with no band less than 7 or equivalent.**

✓ For the **MIT, GDIT, GCIT, MBA, GDBA, and GCBA**:

- Minimum IELTS (Academic Module): **6.5 overall with a writing score of 6.0 or equivalent.**

**NOTE:** For students who do not meet the English language requirements, we are pleased to offer an English packaged offer through our partner institutes. This package allows for **up to 6 months (or 24 weeks)** of English language study.

\*Conditions: Scholarships to be offered subject to students who are meeting the conditions as follows:

- Students should successfully pass a minimum of 75% of enrolled units in the previous trimester.
- Scholarships are available if full payment is made on time. Non- payment of tuition fees on time may lead to the forfeiture of the scholarship entitlement for the term.
- For students who change the enrolled program after the first trimester of study, scholarships will not be claimed.
- For students who repeat units or who study as non- award/ cross-institutional, scholarships will not be claimed.

- For students who have a reduced study load due to the credit transfer based on previous study either from Australia or overseas, the scholarships will be reduced based on the number of units to study.
